In founding Friends, Susan Orkin and Chris Wasserstein sought to level the playing field for children. The vision of Friends of New York City Nurse-Family Partnership is for all babies in New York City to have an equal opportunity to thrive. We believe the New York City Nurse-Family Partnership program is the best model to achieve this vision. By supporting them fully, mothers create financial stability and break the cycle of poverty.



As women in the helping professions, Susan and Chris recognized the power of promoting good outcomes for babies at the earliest moment possible. When they discovered Nurse-Family Partnership in New York City and learned that it had no means for philanthropic contributions, they decided to do something. What began as an idea to help at-risk families succeeded beyond their wildest imagination. We have awarded more than \$450,000 and assisted 480 mothers.

In running our programs, we identified areas of unmet need. Over the last year, Friends has undertaken a strategic planning process that will propel our organization forward. Our strategic plan charts a course toward operational excellence, financial security, and organizational stability. Our plan allows us to leverage our partnerships, our program, and our demonstrated history of success to engage more mothers, expand our work, and build resiliency.

The following outlines in broad strokes some of the points of our operational plan. These strategic initiatives will be the groundwork for our organization over the next three to five years.

Career Awareness and Training Program (Self-Sufficiency/Economic Security)

We will partner with Sanctuary for Families to give our clients an in-depth understanding of the information and tools to obtain family-sustaining careers. Sanctuary runs an outstanding and well-tested career readiness program that will provide clients with the tools and training they need to take control of their future. NFP nurses get clients started by helping them think about career goals; and we will now supplement those initial efforts with specific advice, direction, and guidance.

An Alumni Association (Social Support)

We have begun the work to develop an alumni association that will help stimulate both networking opportunities and friendships, allow clients to make connections and solve shared challenges after their graduation.

Emergency Funds (Health and Mental Health)

During the pandemic, we offered more than \$100,000 to help clients procure everyday essentials when shelves were empty, or prices were high: diapers, personal care items, and food. In light of the continued lack of resources and services, we expanded our Heart's Desire program to include short-term funds. Our goal is to prevent homelessness and food insecurity and reduce stress caused by poverty. This is often exacerbated by the delays in the bureaucratic systems meant to alleviate poverty (e.g. Welfare, Unemployment insurance) and address the well-being of mothers and children.

Supplemental Mental Health Services

We intend to pay for a carefully selected set of short-term, body-based therapies that experts recommend for women who have experienced trauma.
